### November 2, 2022 Council Meeting Notes

- Picture Directory plans are well underway, and Council thanks Jeanette and Margriet for all their work! If you have not signed up to get your picture taken or have other questions, please let them know. Also, if the weather on Monday or Tuesday will prevent you from driving, we have people who will pick you up and bring you home.
- The following people have let their names stand for officebearer selection: For Elder: Fred L., Adam O., Peter W. For Deacon: Ken S., Niels V., Tom V. Two elders and one deacon will be chosen by lot at the Congregational Meeting.
- Deacons presented the Proposed 2023 Budget which will be distributed prior to and voted on at the Congregational Meeting.
- Congregational Meeting is set for Wednesday, December 7, 2022 at 7pm.
- Council spent much time discussing the recent Classis Meeting. The meeting exposed a widespread unwillingness among the churches to uphold biblical teaching about human sexuality, Synod 2022's reaffirmation of the CRCNA's long-held beliefs, and CRCNA governing structure. In short, Council believes there is a growing institutional crisis in the CRCNA. Classis asked for more input, and we will prepare another response to the situation and continue to defend God's truth and the CRCNA's beliefs and organizational structure that all officebearers promise to uphold.
