August 6, 2024 Council Meeting Notes

- At the July meeting, Council voted to grant a request from Rev. Leon Johnston that we call him to serve on loan to a church in Saskatchewan. Over the last month, discussions with Classis laid out the process to facilitate Leon's request. Pending Classis approval at the Fall meeting, Leon will serve as an associate pastor of Granum CRC on loan to Bethel Evangelical Lutheran Church in Frontier, SK.
- At Synod 2024, delegates made decisions that upheld previous Synods' decisions regarding the Human Sexuality Report and subsequent declarations of biblical and confessional teaching on sexuality. Synod 2024 also mandated that all officebearers must comply with current CRCNA teachings as they promise to do when they sign the Covenant for Officebearers. - The road sign along the highway was removed because it was becoming more unlevel due to frost heaving. Plans are being made to reinstall it.
